WESTIN COPLEY PLACE BOSTON PURCHASES RENEWABLE ENERGY FROM SUEZ ENERGY RESOURCES

Houston, TX - February 11, 2008 – SUEZ Energy Resources NA, the U.S. retail energy business of SUEZ Energy North America, announced today that it has renewed a contract with Starwood Westin. Starwood has purchased approximately five percent of its energy load in the form of Green-e certified renewable energy credits (RECs) for its Westin Copley Place hotel in Boston, Mass.

“We are excited to go green and show our continued commitment to the environment,” said Michael Jorgensen, General Manager of Westin Copley Place Boston. “Our purchase of Green-e certified renewable energy credits from SUEZ not only will impact local environmental efforts, but help global efforts as well.”

One REC represents the attributes associated with one-megawatt hour of energy from a renewable source. Westin Copley Place Boston has purchased a total of 678 National wind RECs, which ultimately displaces other non-renewable sources from the electric grid.

“We are pleased to be able to offer our customers more environmentally friendly energy in the form of RECs, and we enjoy seeing current customers like Westin Copley Place Boston take leading roles in adopting environmentally sound energy practices,” said Michel Sirat, president and CEO, SUEZ Energy Resources.
