SUEZ ENERGY RESOURCES NA JOINS TEXAS ELECTRICITY PROFESSIONALS ASSOCIATION

HOUSTON, TX – March 10, 2008 – SUEZ Energy Resources NA, the U.S. retail energy business of SUEZ Energy North America, today announced it has been accepted as a member of the Texas Electricity Professionals Association (TEPA).

SUEZ Energy Resources NA was licensed by the Public Utility Commission of Texas as a competitive supplier in October 2002 and currently provides service to commercial and industrial customers in ERCOT. In September 2007, the City of Dallas selected SUEZ Energy Resources to provide the bulk of the city's electricity supply, with nearly 50 percent of the supply coming from renewable resources. Additionally, Basa Resources, Inc., one of the top 20 oil producers in Texas, renewed its contract in December 2007, ensuring that SUEZ Energy Resources supply its power through the year 2014.

"TEPA plays an integral role in the Texas deregulated market by bringing together professionals comprised of aggregators, brokers and consultants along with energy suppliers," said Gail Workman, Regional Vice President for ERCOT, SUEZ Energy Resources NA. "SUEZ is pleased to become a member of this knowledgeable organization. As a TEPA member, we can now leverage this vast network to foster and develop growth in the indirect channel business."

SUEZ Energy Resources NA currently serves commercial and industrial customers in 10 states: Texas, Massachusetts, Maine, Maryland, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Connecticut, Delaware and also Washington, D.C. The company serves approximately 25,000 customer accounts, mainly with commercial and industrial customers having peak demands ranging from 50 KW to more than 200 MW, for a total contracted load of 4,500 MW.

Based in Houston, SUEZ Energy North America, Inc. is the business unit of SUEZ Energy International responsible for managing SUEZ's positions within the energy value chain in the United States, Mexico, and Canada, including electricity generation and cogeneration, natural gas and liquefied natural gas (LNG), asset-based trading and origination, and retail energy sales and related services to commercial and industrial customers.

SUEZ Energy North America owns and/or operates a total of 46 power, cogeneration, steam, and chilled-water facilities, including those in construction, representing a capacity of more than 5,660 MW of electricity generation, 6.0 million pounds per hour of steam, and 41,973 tons per hour of chilled water. SUEZ Energy North America's wholly owned subsidiary, Distrigas of Massachusetts, owns and operates a liquefied natural gas receiving terminal in Everett, Mass., which began operations in 1971 and currently serves most of the gas utilities in New England and key power producers, meeting approximately 20 percent of New England's annual gas demand. In addition, SUEZ Energy North

America has two LNG deepwater port projects under development off the coasts of Massachusetts and Florida.
